


5 DON'Ts

Avoid doing this at all cost!



5 DOs

Invest in these 5 things!



DON'Ts

Focus solely on the landing zone

Staff the CCoE with non-dedicated resources

Spend a disproportionate amount of time on laaS

Underestimate the importance of a clear operating model

Forget to establish a FinOps function from the start

DOs

Set clear objectives for the cloud migration

Engage with platform users and listen to their feedback



Build relationships with Finance, CISO and other stakeholders

Drive customer success by offering training & certification

Focus on the full DevOps experience
